Seymour Police Department Code Enforcement

Code enforcement is a function of the Seymour Police Department. The primary goal of these efforts is preserving our neighborhoods and eliminating hazards that could affect public safety, while at the same time working to protect the character and small town atmosphere of the City of Seymour.

The codes enforced deal primarily with public nuisances, land and zoning regulations and health and safety violations.

Some of the more common violations involve:

- Unregistered and/or Inoperable vehicles stored in the open
- Vehicles parked in the street for prolonged periods
- Trash and visible junk and/or debris on the property
- Overgrown vegetation & grass, which can contribute to mosquito and rodent infestations
- Keeping of fowl / animals in non-agricultural districts

The department prefers to work cooperatively with property owners in resolving ordinance violations, but occasionally more direct enforcement is necessary. If you receive a Notice of Violation, please work to resolve the violation quickly and notify us when you have done so.

To resolve a code complaint we ask that you first talk to your neighbor and try to resolve the issue. If that fails you may contact City Hall or the Police Department to file a complaint.
