Ordinance Discussion: Alderman Dan Wehmer asked everyone to turn to page 2, the line that address's grocery stores. Alderman Wehmer interprets this line that the grocery stores and gas stations are allowed to sell alcohol. The Board is in agreement that they interpret it the same way. Alderman Wehmer feels the liquor store should not be able to stay open. Alderman Jim Ashley agrees the liquor store is not an essential business. This ordinance will close the hair salons and Terry Kelly's Circle K Trading. The Board of Aldermen agreed that the liquor store can sell at their drive thru window only. The ordinance was changed stating this.
